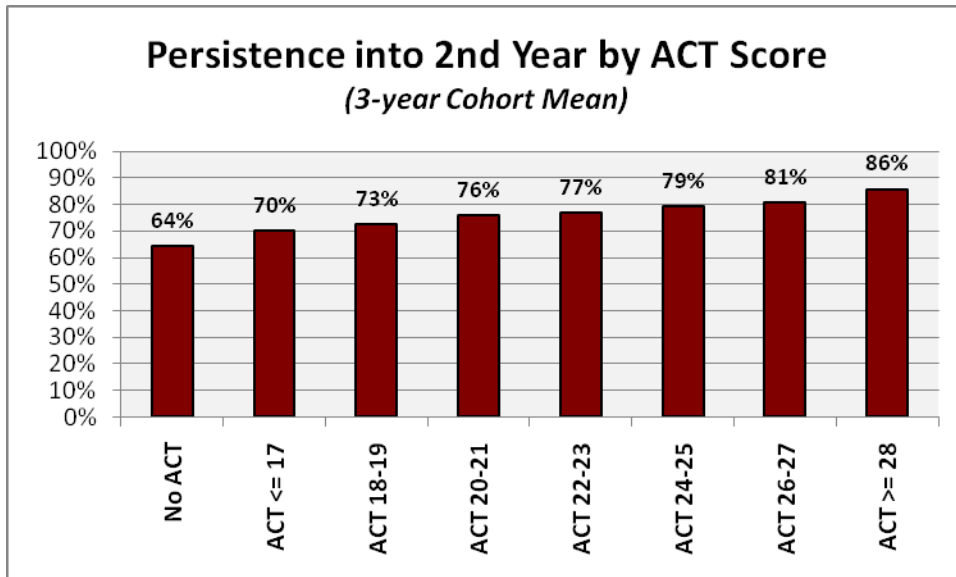

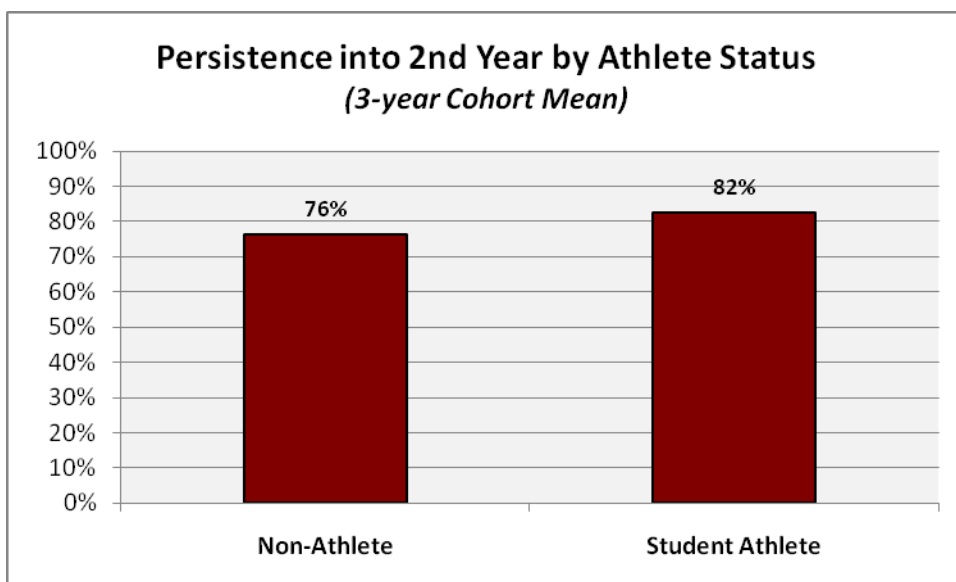
## Summary

This report contains information about the persistence and graduation rates of Central Michigan University On-campus First-Time Freshmen entering CMU in the fall semesters between 1999 and 2008. The major findings are:

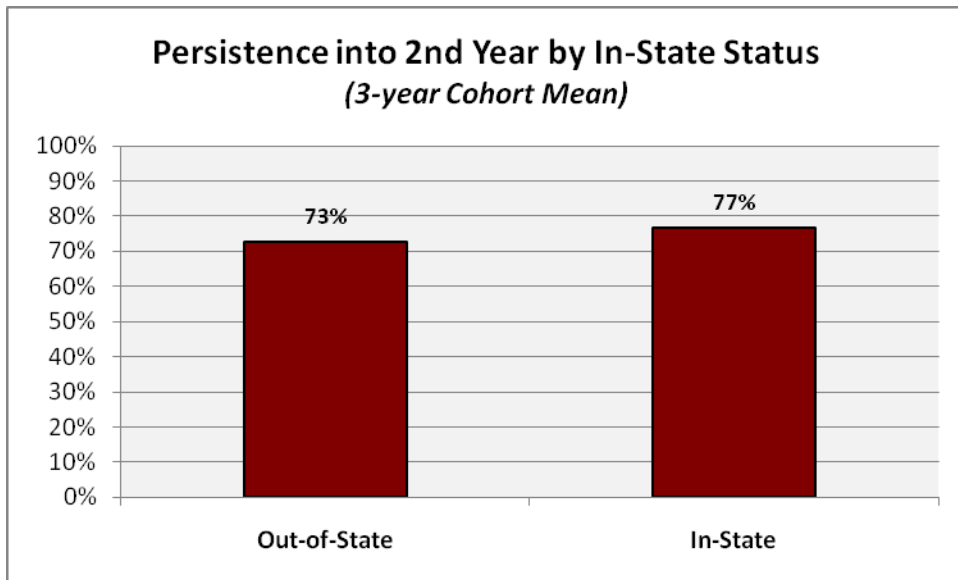
- Approximately 86% of first-time freshmen entering CMU in the fall semesters of 2006, 2007, and 2008 with ACT composite scores 28 or greater began their second year at CMU. In comparison, 77% of first-time freshmen with ACT of 22 or 23 (median ACT = 22) continued to their second year.



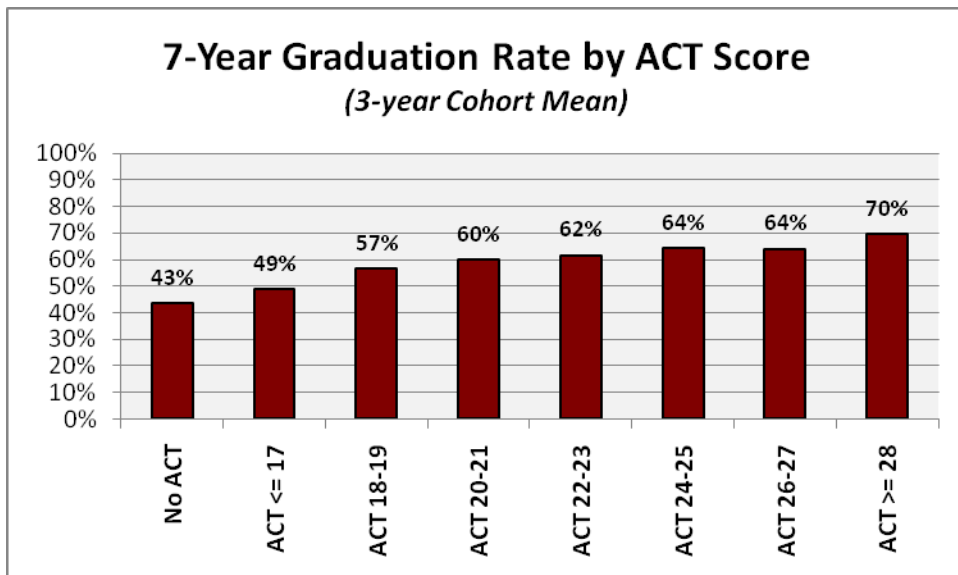
- About 82% of first-time freshmen student athletes entering CMU in the fall semesters of 2006, 2007, and 2008 began their second year at CMU. While 76% of non-student athletes continued to their second year.



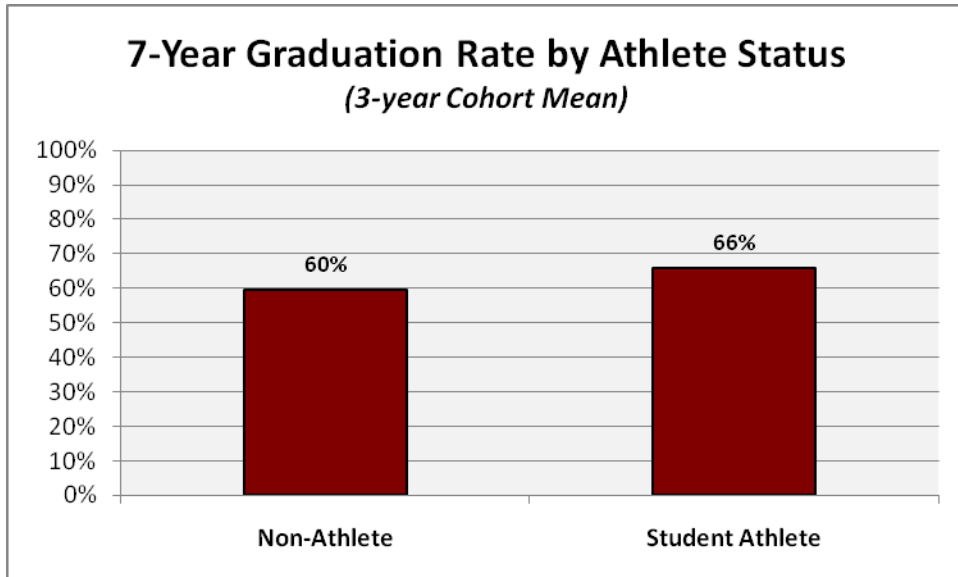
- On average, persistence rates of In-State first-time freshmen are higher than persistence rates of Out-of-State students.



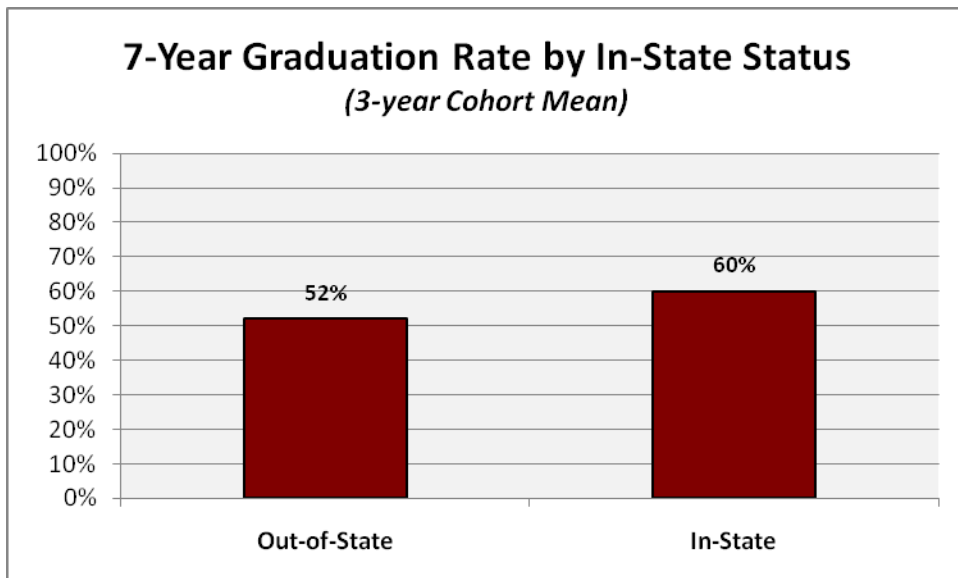
- Of a typical first-time freshmen class scoring 22 or 23 (median ACT = 22) on the ACT, about 62% graduate from CMU within seven years. About 57% of first-time freshmen scoring 18 or 19 on the ACT will graduate within seven years.



- For CMU's first-time freshmen, student athletes are more likely to graduate than non-student athletes in seven years or less. However, non-student athletes are more likely than student athletes to graduate in four years or less (see Table 2B).



- On average, Out-of-State first-time freshmen have a four year or less graduation rate of 20% compared to 19% for In-State students (see Table 2C). Conversely, nearly 60% of In-State students entering CMU in the fall semesters of 2006, 2007, and 2008 graduated in seven years or less while about 52% of Out-of-State students finished in the same time period.



## Introduction

The Office of Institutional Research conducts an on-going study of persistence and graduation rates of on-campus undergraduate students at Central Michigan University titled "[\*Persistence and Graduation Rates of CMU On-campus First-time Freshmen\*](#)." This report provides supplemental retention and graduation rate statistics for first-time freshmen with breakdowns for ACT composite score, student athletes and non-student athletes, In-State students (based on county of origin) and Out-of-State students.

For this study, ACT composite score groups were defined using all scores for each first-time freshmen cohorts included in the study. Approximately 97.5% of first-time freshmen in the 2006, 2007, and 2008 cohorts combined submitted ACT scores upon admission. Weighted means for the last three years have been calculated for persistence and graduation rates to add stability to subgroups where the number of students is small. Also, for this study, a student is defined as having persisted into a given semester if he or she attended CMU during that semester or had previously graduated from CMU with a baccalaureate degree. Non-persisters include transfers (students who have transferred to other colleges/universities), stopouts (those who have dropped out temporarily and who will return to college in the future), and dropouts (those who no longer will continue with their education).
